- Support clients with community integration, resource linkage, and coordination of care
- Collaborate with therapists, psychiatric providers, case managers, schools, families, and external agencies
- Provide psychoeducation related to mental health symptoms, medication adherence, wellness, and recovery goals
- Observe, document, and report client progress, barriers, and behavioral concerns in a timely and accurate manner
- Maintain complete, compliant, and timely documentation in the electronic health record (EHR) per COMAR, Medicaid, and CARF standards
- Participate in treatment team meetings, supervision, and required trainings
- Adhere to all MPC policies, ethical standards, confidentiality (HIPAA), and safety protocols
